WinteRace: tomorrow the second stage

The WinteRace Cortina 2024 started regularly today at 9:00 am from Corso Italia in Cortina d'Ampezzo amidst a delicate and suggestive snowfall. Among the most significant cars registered for the eleventh edition of the WinteRace are the Alfa Romeo 8C-2300 that participated in the 24 Hours of Le Mans on June 3rd and the 1958 Triumph TR 3, an original car used in Federico Fellini's film "La Dolce Vita".

Cortina d'Ampezzo. The WinteRace Cortina 2024 started regularly at 9:00 am from Corso Italia in Cortina d'Ampezzo amidst a delicate and suggestive snowfall. Snow is a co-star of this edition, offering participants the chance to experience the Dolomite winter. The organization had to revise part of the route, avoiding the Valparola and Gardena passes, instead following the direction of Arabba to reach Selva di Val Gardena, crossing the Pordoi and Sella passes. The cars starting the eleventh edition of the Winterace 2024 tomorrow will be engaged in the second stage that will determine the rankings. After starting at 9:00 am from Corso Italia in Cortina d'Ampezzo, the crews will tackle the Passo Giau, descending to Selva di Cadore to cross Forcella Staulanza and Forcella Cibiana before reaching Pieve di Cadore, where the cars are expected to be presented to the public around 11:00 am. From Pieve di Cadore, the cars will reach Auronzo, then divert towards the Passo di Sant'Antonio to descend to Padola, where they will head towards the Passo Monte Croce Comelico for lunch at the Hotel Kreuzberg ****. After lunch, the crews will head towards San Candido and Dobbiaco to reach the Franz Kraler Luxury Multibrand store. The return to Cortina will see the cars passing along Lake Misurina and crossing the Passo Tre Croci before arriving at Corso Italia in Cortina d'Ampezzo for the final parade starting at 4:00 pm. Among the most significant cars participating in the eleventh edition of the WinteRace, which can also be admired tomorrow, is car number 7: the Alfa Romeo 8C-2300 that participated in the 24 Hours of Le Mans on June 3rd and a 1958 Triumph TR 3, an original car used in Federico Fellini's film "La Dolce Vita".
